The Green Step partner countries are proud to announce that two of our Project Results, i.e., PR1: THE GREEN STEP CURRICULUM and PR2: THE GREEN STEP COMMUNITY PROGRAMME have now been developed. The Green Step project aspires to support, raise awareness, and build capacity about environmental and climate-change challenges in the sphere of adult

education to help both adult educators and learners develop knowledge, skills, values and behaviour.

PR1: THE GREEN STEP CURRICULUM

The innovative Curriculum has been created with the aim of upskilling and enhancing the sustainability skills of adult educators/trainers. It can function either as a standalone course material or as an addendum to existing material that lack the element of the education for sustainability. By using the Curriculum, adult educators/trainers will be able to help their adult learners, including migrant learners, understand and reflect on sustainability issues and

how they can develop their competences.

In our development of the Curriculum, we have been focusing on the five very important topics of: Climate Action, Green Cities and Communities, Responsible Consumption, Zero Waste and Upcycling, Green Jobs and Green Economy. Each topic makes up a chapter in the Curriculum and contains an introduction to the topic, valuable facts and information, learning objectives and inspiration for the future.

PR2: THE GREEN STEP COMMUNITY PROGRAMME

This programme aims to promote the development of adult learners by improving knowledge and skills associated with self-transformation within issues associated with sustainability and climate action empowering learners of any cultural background to transform themselves and the community they live in; enabling a transition to greener economies and societies; equipping them with skills for 'green jobs'; motivating the adaptation of sustainable lifestyles; stimulating learning and promoting core competences.

The stimulating and engaging activities in the programme are there to transmit fundamental issues of sustainability and climate change. For many adult learners there is a need to acquire new

"green" skills that will support their transition to greener economies and societies, but also help them transform themselves, i.e., to change their mindsets. It is a flexible, easily adaptable, local learning programme adapted to the learning needs of adults in the different partner countries but also to learning needs on a global level. Many of the included activities have an element of hands-on learning and the inclusion of the learners' own experience, knowledge and their local context while disseminating new valuable insight, eye-openers and knowledge.
